










DID YOU KNOW?

BALLOT LANGUAGE

PROPOSITION A:

THE ISSUANCE OF \$240,000,000 OF BONDS BY THE CADDO MILLS INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DIS-TRICT FOR SCHOOL FACILITIES AND LAND, AND LEVYING THE TAX IN PAYMENT THEREOF. THIS IS

A PROPERTY TAX INCREASE.
